

# El Camino Real Park

## Completed 2008

The project site marks the northern gateway into the City's historic downtown area, at the southwest corner of Camino Capistrano and La Zanja and one block north of Mission San Juan Capistrano. The project replaces an aged park area that has been neglected over the years and was revitalized with California native plants, pedestrian walkways, equestrian fencing, Valencia orange grove, California Sycamore trees and a decorative monument that commemorated the project. The project has proven to be an improvement upon the overall aesthetics of the area while providing visual appeal, linking this area to downtown San Juan Capistrano.

The planting was installed by community volunteers, children from the neighborhood, OC Master Gardeners and City staff. Plant material was both purchased and donated through local nurseries that specialize in growing native trees and plants.
