*Guided tours of the downtown, Los Rios Historic District, the post modern Library designed by Michael Graves, and the Mission San Juan Capistrano are available to residents and visitors.*

- *Historical Walking Tours of San Juan Capistrano offered on Sundays at 1:00 p.m. Meet at the Train Depot Platform off Verdugo Street. Tour takes about 1 hour and guests will have the opportunity to visit the Adobe Indian Museum, Victorian Homes & Adobe Homes. Guest will also enjoy listening to stories and legends of the City's old Mission Town. Donation is \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for children. Architectural examples include Adobe, Victorian, Craftsman, Spanish Revival, Eclectic, Streamline Moderne, and Post-Modern structures.
