SDG&E Industrial Programs



- Energy Efficiency Business Incentives (formerly SPC)
 - Program offers incentive payments for energy-efficient projects involving the installation of new, high-efficiency equipment or systems – gas or electric
 - Incentives are paid based on the amount of documented energy saved
 - Lighting - \$0.05/kWh \$100/Peak kW
 - A/C & Refrigeration - \$0.15/kWh \$100/Peak kW
 - Other (motors, fans, etc.) - \$0.09/kWh \$100/Peak kW
 - Natural Gas - \$1.00 Therm

SDG&E Programs & Services



- Energy Efficiency Business Incentives (SPC) – cont.
 - Pre-inspections and post inspections are required on all projects.
 - Applicants are eligible to receive up to 50% of the cost for each project, for calculated measures or the incentive amount, whichever is less.
 - If a business rebate is available for the same measure we will refer the customer to the business rebate program.
 - Benchmarking is a requirement.
 - If Measurement & Verification is required the customer will receive 60% of the incentive upon installation and the 40% balance after the verification period.



- Energy Efficiency Business Rebates
 - Provides rebates to businesses to retro-fit or upgrade equipment to be more energy efficient
 - Lighting, Refrigeration, Food Service, Natural Gas, and Other Technologies
 - Working to have rebate levels statewide consistent
 - New products added:
 - Led Fixtures, Led Case Lighting, T8 to T8, Motors
 - Lighting products require the collection of wattage and technology information for existing and new lamps
 - Some measures require pre-inspection

- Calculate rebate
 - For non-lighting products complete the Rebate Product Information table
 - For lighting measures complete the lighting worksheet
- Calculate and submit Annual Hours of Operation worksheet
- Submit Rebate Application



Energy Savings Bid

- Incentive amounts for nonresidential energy-saving retrofit projects are standard
 - Lighting: Interior - \$.10/kWh
 - Lighting: Exterior - \$.07/kWh
 - A/C & Refrigeration - \$.20/kWh
 - Natural Gas - \$1.00/therm
 - Incentive amount cannot exceed the measure cost
 - Proposal may be made for increased incentive amounts
- Minimum annual savings must be >500,000 kWh or 25,000 therms
 - A single large effort (i.e. one site, one customer)
 - Aggregated (i.e. multiple sites, multiple customers)

- Commercial Direct Install (DI) Program
 - This is a new program which launched on February 1, 2011
 - Statewide program being implemented through three contractors selected by an RFP process.
 - Provides energy efficiency products and installation to eligible customers at no cost.
 - Targets small and medium commercial customers with electrical demands less than 100 kilowatts
 - Per the benchmarking guidelines a benchmarking score of exemption is required for each site.
