INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that on December 6, 2016, the City Council will consider adoption of an Ordinance entitled:

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 6-3.03, 6-3.08.01, 6-3.08.02, AND 6-3.08.03 OF CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 6 OF THE SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE, MINIMUM CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS DIVERSION REQUIREMENTS”

Effective January 1, 2017, in all jurisdictions the owners/builder of construction projects within the covered occupancies will be required to divert 65 percent of the construction waste materials generated during the project. In order to meet these goals it is necessary that the City promote the reduction of solid waste and reduce the stream of solid waste going to landfills. This includes waste from construction, demolition, and renovation of buildings represents a significant portion of the quantity of waste presently coming from the City of San Juan Capistrano, and much of this waste is particularly suitable for recycling and reuse.
