City Council Meeting Schedule: To encourage voter participation in Tuesday's (March 3) Primary Election, next week's City Council meeting will be held on Monday, March 2.

Wall of Recognition Ceremony: The City Council created the Wall of Recognition in 2000 to recognize individuals whose contributions to the community have made the City of San Juan Capistrano a more productive and enjoyable place to live, work and visit. In appreciation for their many years of service to the community, on November 5, 2019, the City Council selected Marianne Taylor, Ray Miller and Jim Taylor to be included on the Wall of Recognition. Verdugo Project Update: Construction of the Verdugo Street Beautification Project continued this week with the installation of pavers, concrete pedestals for the new planting pots and new streetlights. The City's contractor installed new curb and gutter along the east side of Camino Capistrano in preparation for additional sidewalk work scheduled to take place next week.



Metrolink Nighttime Railroad Maintenance: From March 2 through March 6, Metrolink crews will be performing nighttime track maintenance between Avenida Aeropuerto and the Del Obispo Street Crossing. Each evening, maintenance work will take place from 8:00 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. the following morning. All maintenance activities are scheduled to be complete by Friday, March 6 at 4:30 a.m. According to Metrolink, potential impacts during the work could include noise from equipment back-up alarms, noise and vibrations from construction machinery, and increased lighting. 
