

Multi-Modal Parking Lot Entrance Detour: To accommodate construction activity currently underway at the Capistrano Plaza, located at the northwest corner of Camino Capistrano and Verdugo Street, the east entrance to the City's Multi-modal parking lot will be temporarily closed for approximately two to three weeks. The west entrance to the parking lot, located between Rancho Capistrano Winery and Trevor's at the Tracks, has been converted to safely accommodate two-way traffic. Adjacent business owners have been notified of the temporary closure, and signage and traffic control devices are in place to assist motorists.
